ABOUT BARCA LUI ZOE

Barca lui Zoe (Zoe's Boat) is an underwater and ecological education program with a social role which aims to inspirit children, teenagers, and adults from Romania to overcome their fears (especially those related to water), have the courage to discover the underwater world, practice underwater sports, carefully observe Nature's diverse manifestations, acknowledge its vital importance in our lives, and nurture the sense of responsibility, care and respect towards it.



Barca lui Zoe - an underwater education project which aims to encourage underwater explorations, the joy of simple things, and the protection of Nature.

Underwater experiences can lead to a powerful shift in perspective. The simple fact that beneath the surface of the water there are landscapes beyond our wildest imagination is a trigger strong enough for a person's mind. The way in which the underwater world takes shape and manifests itself is another important trigger for the mind of those who get to have the underwater experience. The sensation of no gravity and spending time in an aquatic environment are therapeutic activities, which benefits breathing, improves cardiovascular health and the muscular system. Underwater sports are relatively easy to practice. Yet, the joys of the experiences are surprising.

Spending so much time in the water, we understand the importance of clean waters, leaving as little traces as possible - and even picking up the ones we find, and we want to educate others to do the same. Given the current consumption habits, it is important to have a strict conduct regarding the waste generated. Thus, environmental protection is a topic of particular concern to us.

MOTIVATION

What keeps us going

- According to the studies, less than 5% of the water on Earth has been explored so far.
- In Romania underwater sports are still newcomers, although they bring significant benefits both for the mind and the body.
- We hold the second place in Europe in terms of sedentary. 51% of Romanians never get involved in physical activities.
- The fear of water is wide-spread in Romanian culture. We see underwater sports as more than adequate means to overcome this fear and make room for the joy of living and experiencing life.
- Awareness of this astonishing world can lead to an increased responsibility for the way we treat the most important resource of the planet: the water in the oceans and the seas.
- In Romania, ecological education does not have a clearly established legal framework. Children only optionally learn about the importance of protecting the environment.
- In Romania there has not been (nor is there yet) a culture of recycling and ecological responsibility.

WHERE WE ARE TODAY

In June 2020 Barca lui Zoe finished its second year of activity with a total of 4 recurrent events in which over 3000 people (children, pupils, students and adults) were directly involved.

According to the participants' feedback, the events were not only appreciated, but they also left a strong imprint in their everyday practice, which gives us confidence that we have the right approach to reach our main objectives.

During these three years of activity, we have promoted online, offline, and in national mass media the messages we believe in:

For two months, tourists from Vama Veche to Navodari resorts and residents of the Black Sea towns were invited to become aware of the impact accidentally thrown trash has. By picking up a garbage bag collected from the beach and bringing it to Zoe's Boat or a partner diving centre, the participants received in exchange an underwater experience like snorkeling, free-diving or scuba-diving.





ALTERNATIVE SCHOOL

Already at the second edition, our in presence schools during Alternative Week has become a tradition. In the 2019-2020 school year, over 5000 pupils enrolled for the introduction in underwater activities and ecological education event. Compared to the previous year, the purposed event had a new and unique element that was very well received by the Alongside the classic pupils. conversation about the underwater world and the importance of a responsible behaviour towards nature, we introduced the pupils to the underwater world with 3D videos projected on virtual reality goggles. Thus, we tried to get as close as possible to objective reality. However, no matter how advanced technology is today, the real experience is far rewarding.

The practical exercises using snorkeling equipment were also a delight for the children present at the event. The fact that they could test breathing through a snorkel and that they learned how to correctly put on a snorkeling mask helped them realise that underwater activities are not as complicated as they seem.










"REMAIN CALM IN ANY SITUATION FOR PEACE MEANS POWER" Alongside the main benefits of underwater activities, there is also the state of calm that is experienced by those who open their eyes beneath the water's surface. Studies show that looking at fish in a tank has therapeutic effects in cases of stress, high blood pressure, or insomnia.


Given the uncertain situation, the hourly changes and the panic created by the lockdown imposed in the context of coronavirus, we have used Barca lui Zoe's social media accounts to post daily videos of underwater life.

The gentle movement of underwater life together with soothing background music had the desired effect. The community appreciated our initiative and reacted positively to the videos posted.

Being calm is one of the skills that every underwater sportsman learns during explorations. Panic is one of the main reasons for drowning. Therefore, in the aquatic environment, the most important thing is to exercise and maintain calm.




ECO EXPERIENCE



Zoe's Boat, currently docked in the Life Harbour Marina, is an open space for any person responsible with Nature. Spending time on Zoe's Boat means experiencing a the simple life, without habitual contemporary comfort. By default, the level of trash generated declines exponentially. Due to its location, connecting with Nature is effortless and more profound. Among the activities we suggest to those that take up the challenge to experience the simple life, generating low waste and a zero-carbon footprint, there are:

- Hiking to the Limanu Cave, one of the longest caves in Dobrogea
- Sailing on Lake Limanu / the Black Sea
- Gathering mussels from Lake Limanu
- Underwater explorations

In order to have this type of experiences, in exchange for a 120L garbage bag collected from Nature, those who wish it can spend a night on Zoe's Boat, without a time limit.



TEAM BUILDING

2019 - 2020

It is important for a team to have a common vision and language. The team buildings organised for the exploration of the underwater world offered members of the participant teams this very ace up their sleeve: a new common vision, a new angle of approach that all team members can take into account, and an experience which only those who lived it can talk about. SNORKELING INITIATION





Thus, they safely learned the floating practice, the technique of a long breath underwater. through a snorkeling tube. the best practices in different cases that might arise during explorations, and safety rules.

PRIVATE EXPLORATIONS

Oftentimes we reserve time private underwater explorations. This way the connection with the self is much more profound. Time and attention are completely focused on the sensations and our own experiences, which provide opportunity to quietly observe ourselves. Thus, we gather precious information situations that regarding during could arise explorations, and how to overcome them.

Our objectives are to first know of all new extreme situations so that we can offer the best information to underwater sports enthusiasts. Also, during our explorations, we discover places that are just right for snorkeling, both in Romania and abroad.






SOCIAL MEDIA


BENEFICIARIES
